

AZNN Adult/Youth Survey Protocol

The AZNN Adult Survey will be used in FY15 to measure the behaviors and knowledge of adults in Arizona who we aim to impact with a number of strategies. Similarly, the AZNN Youth Survey will be used to measure the behaviors and knowledge of Arizona youth who we aim to impact as well (Please see the Evaluation Framework and AZNN Tool listing for all strategies that will be evaluated in part by the Adult/Youth Survey).

These surveys are to be used for both PSE and direct education strategies. At each site that will be impacted by a strategy that requires one of the tools, the survey is required to be given once at the beginning of the series and again at the end of the series. A series is defined as two or more sessions where the majority of participants are the same. An individual session is NOT a series. Upon receipt of the Spanish surveys, contractors are expected to administer the survey immediately and that would act as the “pre-test” for the series. In circumstances where a series is ongoing, contractors should administer the survey at the beginning of the year prior to any of the year’s planned activities (pre-test) and at the end of the year after the year’s planned activities have been completed (post-test).

Adult Surveys should be offered to a group of adults who have been identified as the target for the strategy(ies) at each site. AZNN partner staff should proctor the survey and those partners who have IRB approval for research should follow all their IRB required protocols.

Each time the survey is administered at a site a coversheet will be completed and the surveys and coversheet will be sent to ADHS at the following address:
